**ADOPTION OF THE MINUTES FROM THE PREVIOUS MEETINGS-** Alderman Eric Gaither made the motion to adopt the minutes from the previous meeting. Alderman Antonio Carter seconded the motion and the motion carried unanimously.

**ADOPTIONS OF FORMAL AGENDA-** Alderman Antonio Carter made the motion to adopt the formal agenda. Alderman Billy Retterbush seconded the motion and the motion carried unanimously.

**NEW BUSINESS**

1. **Affidavit & Resolution for November 10, 2014 Executive Session** – Mitchell Moore presented the Affidavit & Resolution to the council. A motion was made by Alderman Billy Retterbush to approve the Affidavit and Resolution. Alderwoman Mellisa Watson seconded the motion and the motion carried unanimously.
2. **Five Year Comprehensive Plan Resolution** – Mandy Luke presented a Resolution of the Five Year Comprehensive Plan. A motion was made by Antonio Carter to approve the resolution. Eric Gaither seconded the motion and the motion carried unanimously.

3. **City Manager's/Finance Director's Report** - Mandy Luke reminded the council of the Thanksgiving lunch on Wednesday, November 26, 2014 at noon. The council discussed

allowing the city staff to close early & leave at 2:00 after the lunch November 26, 2014. A motion was made by Billy Retterbush to approve this decision. The motion was seconded by Mellisa Watson and the motion carried unanimously. Mandy Luke informed the council that the City received an award for the Chaparral EIP for a grant for \$500,000 for water improvements. Mandy Luke commended Jackie Jordan for her help as the new City Clerk.

4. **City Attorney's Report** – Mitchell Moore discussed the EIP and gave an update on Gas project with Dupont Pine Products easements for gas line. He stated he spoke to Bryan Shaw on the historic district signage. Temporary signs are the only problems that we have run into so far and there is a possibility of an amendment where this is concerned. Mitchell further reported he met with Randy Lane and Kim Hobbs last week about the 18 unit property. He also spoke to Ed Blevins about the property and mentioned the land bank option but county has to work with us on it in order to do it.
5. **Department Head's** – Peter Schultz reported on that the Cherry Drive culvert pipe work is completed and they are working to get the road opened back up. Chief Edwards reported that one of the new Tahoe vehicles has been completed & assigned to Officer Timothy Jernigan.
