He said he wants to begin with one building that is 100 feet long that will house five (5) – 10’ x 10’ units and ten (10) – 5’ x 10’ units. Mayor Richbourg asked about the current zoning. Henry Yawn said it is NS which is neighborhood shopping and Perkins is zoned DR-10 which is one and two-family residences. After brief discussion, the Mayor and Council asked Mr. Sullens to provide a drawing that is more to scale regarding the set-backs and it would be reviewed at the next Council meeting.
