NEW BUSINESS

Personnel Matters: A special called meeting was held March 3, 2020 to discuss personal matters. Mayor Scarbrough called the meeting to order. Scott Stalnaker presented a request from the City Manager for a temporary leave of absence stating she has leave time available. Billy Retterbush made a motion to grant the City Manager a temporary leave of absence of up to three (3) weeks but if more time is needed, another meeting would be scheduled for discussion at that time. John Clayton seconded the motion and the motion carried unanimously. Scott Stalnaker said in the past Peter Schultz was appointed to handle the day to day operations and finances while the City Manager was absent, which is her recommendation at this time. Antonio Carter made a motion to appoint Peter Schultz to oversee day to day operations and finances with the same limit of the City Manager of \$10,000 but if anything comes up over that limit, it would be brought before the Council. Scott Stalnaker seconded the motion. Antonio Carter, Scott Stalnaker, John Clayton and Billy Retterbush voted in favor of the motion. Eric Gaither voted against the motion. The motion carries four (4) to one (1).

Discussions about possible Executive Session determined to be unnecessary.

There being no further business to conduct, Antonio Carter made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 6:34 p.m. Eric Gaither seconded the motion and the motion carried unanimously.
